Important things to know before you go:

- Camp Ravencloff is located on a hillside, so be prepared for some walking and uneven terrain.
- The cabins are rustic and have no electricity, but flush toilets and hot showers are available in centralized restrooms.
- Parking is remote, so be prepared to transport your belongings about 200 yards from the loading zone to your cabin, and then move your car to the remote lot where it will remain for the duration of the weekend.
- The camp is drug, alcohol, and tobacco-free.

Family Camp Registration & Fees:

Each family reserves their own cabin and may include up to 10 people of their choosing in the cabin. Fees are per person.

\$325 per person for the first 4 people
\$175 per person for additional people in same cabin
Children under age 4 are free

Unfortunately, animals are not allowed at Camp Ravencloff. (except the ones who live there year-round)
